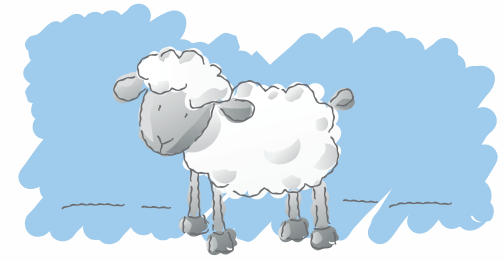

EVERY CHILD DESERVES A SAFE AND HEALTHY ENVIRONMENT

Little Lambs helps protect our community's most vulnerable citizens – infants and young children – by rewarding their parents for healthy parental acts on their behalf. It requires community effort to keep infants and children safe. Little Lambs partners with obstetric and pediatric physicians, hospitals, substance abuse programs, social services agencies, health departments, and many other medical and educational organizations serving parents and their children.

A CIRCLE OF SAFETY

When parents participate in partnering organization programs that promote healthy babies and families they receive Little Lambs vouchers. These vouchers can be traded at the Little Lambs store for baby equipment and supplies including infant and toddler car seats, safety gates, cribs, diapers, and more. With each contact the circle of safety around infants and children is strengthened. At the forefront of child protection, parents are supported and rewarded for healthy parental behaviors.

LITTLE LAMBS' ROLE IS TO...

- Encourage parents to develop healthy parenting techniques and behaviors
- Provide safety-tested baby equipment and supplies
- Increase public awareness of the need and benefits of prenatal and well-baby care
- Educate parents on protecting their infants and children in their homes and on our roads

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Any pregnant woman or parent/guardian of a child 7 years of age or younger can earn Little Lambs vouchers redeemable for equipment and supplies at the Little Lambs store. Vouchers are offered for pre-natal and well-baby check-ups, staying in school, attending rehab sessions as well as parenting and nutrition classes, and more. Numbers are increasing but currently about 11,000 vouchers are distributed annually by 32 agencies in the area. There are no income limitations for those participating.
