Children under the age of eight in Indiana are required to be in a car seat while in the car. For those that qualify car seats are available at Little Lambs for 20 vouchers or \$20.00.

**You must schedule an appointment for a car seat and your child must be present at the appointment.**

If your child needs a car seat and you cannot afford one please let us know.



Each car seat has age, height, and weight requirements that **MUST** be followed. Look at the information on the side of the car seat. At a car seat appointment, you will meet with a car seat technician for about 45 minutes to learn how to install and use your child's car seat.

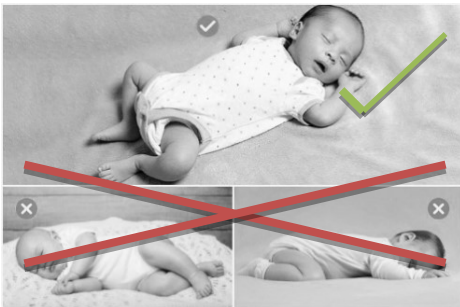

An infant's bed should have a firm and  
flat mattress.

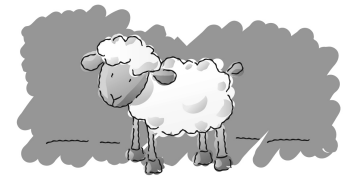
**If you do not have a safe place for  
your baby to sleep let us know.**

Lay an infant on its back when you put  
them to sleep. Sleeping on their back  
is the safest way for an infant to sleep.  
Do not put blankets, stuffed animals,  
or toys in an infant's bed.

Infants should NOT sleep in swings or  
car seats. Infants should nap during  
the day and sleep at night in a "pack n  
play" portable crib or crib.  
The mattress should be firm and flat.
